

WELLER Memory Game

You will need

- Wolols spooky pictures
- Scissors
- Glue
- Cardboard. Try to reuse an empty shoe box, cereal container or cardboard box

How to do it

Print two times each pictures page on cardstock. They look nicer and hold up better! Print off Wolols picture cards and cut out along the squares of each picture

If not possible to print it out in cardboard:

- · Cut out a piece of cardboard of the length of the Wolols picture page
- Glue the Wolols picture page onto the cardboard
- · Cut out along the squares of each picture
- · Your memory cards are ready!







Game cards are ready!

How to play

- 1. Mix up the cards.
- 2. Lay them in rows, face down.
- 3. Turn over any two cards.
- 4. If the two cards match, keep them.
- 5. If they don't match, turn them back over where they are.
- 6. Remember what was on each card and where it was.
- 7. Watch and remember during the other player's turn.
- 8. The game is over when all the cards have been matched.
- 9. The player with the most matches wins.



























Spooky night

WELDLINE Bingo! Game

You will need

- Wolols spooky pictures
- Wolols Bingo boards
- Glue and scissors
- Cardboard. Try to reuse an empty shoe box, cereal container or cardboard box.
- A basket, bowl or box, to keep the bingo game and use it to pull out the pictures cards during the game
- Game markers: buttons, small pieces of paper, whatever you find to cover the pictures on the card boards

Adding fun: small biscuits, little chocolates, gummies or small marshmallows are great for game markers – and the kids can eat some too! Use Halloween sweets ©

How to do it

Use the cards from the Memory Game if you have already printed them off. If not, you just need to print off one copy of each pictures page. Print on card stock. They look nicer and hold up better! Cut out along the squares of each picture.

If not possible to print it off in cardstock and you want to keep them more firmer and durable (recommended):

- Cut out a piece of cardboard of the length of the Wolols picture page
- · Glue the Wolols picture page onto the cardboard
- · Cut out along the squares of each picture
- · Your bingo cards are ready!


WOLDLWEEN Bingo!

Set-Up:

- Be sure to print off enough bingo boards for each one who wants to play. Each one will need a different board game

- Place the bingo cards into a basket, bowl, box or something you can easily pull out from

- Give each player enough game markers



Basic Bingo Rules

- Wolols Bingo boards have 25 squares. The one in the middle is not used
- One player is the caller
- The caller pulls out one picture from the box, and if the picture is on a player's board, its square may be covered with a game marker
- When a player has all pictures covered with game markers, he/she yells out "bingo!" and win the game


Board Variations for Kids

You can change the winning board layout to keep the game more exciting. Here are some ideas: the first person to form an "x" across his or her board wins, or the first person to have a diagonal line, or the first person to have the four corners, or one specific row, or one specific column.































WOLDLWEEN Bowling Game

This is a great activity to reuse and recycle materials.

You will need:

- Empty plastic bottles or containers (washing machine, body wash, shampoo, conditioner, cleaning stuff...)

 You can also use cardboard toilet paper rolls or empty cans (but be sure they have no sharp edges)

- Coloured pencils, markers

- Scissors, Tape and/or glue

- Balls to knock down the skittles. Don't have balls?

- Don't worry! Fill up balloons with sand or even use



- your small fluffy toys to knock down as much skittles as you can!

How to do it? Just add a bit of creativity to transform your skittles. Here you will find some ideas from the Wolols.

- For bottles and containers, take out the label.
- Cut out the Wolols' pictures
- Glue the Wolols pictures onto the container or paper rolls and ready to play!



How to play

- Players knock down skittles by throwing the balls at the skittles. Points are scored for knocking skittles down, and the winner is the team with the highest score
- Choose your 'playing alley', a straight course that you throw the balls down. Make this as long as you feel comfortable from the bowling line to the first skittle
- Set up the Skittles in a line, triangle or diamond shape. Depending on how many skittles will you play with.

WOLDLWEEN Dancing Skeleton

Let's make a dancing Skeleton!

You will need

- Wolols Skeleton pieces
- Scissors
- Pins clips, pipe cleaners or wire to join the holes
- Puncher to make holes (optional, you can always use the scissors)
- Popsicle or Iolly sticks
- Tape and thread
- If you cannot print off in cardstock, use a piece of cardboard (Try to reuse an empty shoe box or cereal container)




















How to do it

- I Print off the skeleton page in cardstock to look nicer and hold up better! or glue the skeleton page onto a piece of cardstock the length of the page and cut out each piece.
- 2 Join the pieces matching the colour of the small holes - green + green, red + red and so on - make the hole with the puncher or the scissors point and, tie up using clips or wire.


Joined pieces should be a little loose so they can move

3- Glue or use tape to make an X with two sticks. On each extreme glue or tie up the thread and glue or use tape to join one thread to the elbow, another to the knee, to move the skeleton moving the X.

It's ready! Put some music and make your skeleton dance!








WOLDLINGTH Grumpy Spider Game

You will need

- Grumpy spider picture
- Scissors
- Masking tape or Blu Tack
- Blindfold








How to do it


- Print off the spider
- Cut out the body and legs
- Place blue tack or masking tape on the end of each leg that joins the spider body

How to play

- Hang with tape the spider body on a wall that is roughly eye level to the players.
- Have the players line up in single file and blindfold the first one in the queue.
- Give this player the spider legs and gently spin him/her around three times.
- Point the blindfolded player towards the spider body and ask him/her to place the legs on the spider
- Mark the spot where he/she places the legs with his name
- Once every player has had a turn, the child with the legs closest to the right position wins.







WELWEEN What did the Zombie eat?

A rascally zombie has ate a few things and you must guess what it was, but you have to search for them introducing your hand through his mouth!

You will need

- Zombie head picture
- Medium size cardboard box
- Scissors and glue
- Box cutter
- Napkin or a piece of cloth
- Bag with items you have around





Use pieces of clothing with textures, small toys, balls, a fork, a piece of Lego, an apple, a fluffy toy, pencils, rubbers, stones, sticks, leaves... Whatever you want!


This is a very fun activity that have as many variants as you wish!

How to do it

- Print off zombie picture
- Glue it onto the cardboard box
- Cut out the hole of the mouth so a child's hand can get through it
- Inside the box tape the napkin or cloth on the top of the mouth, so nobody can see through the hole.

How to play

- Introduce inside the box the "mystery" items and close it. Don't let anyone watch what you put inside!
- Set a timer to one minute, for example
- The player introduce one hand through the yucky zombie mouth and say aloud what she/he is touching, what the zombie ate!
- Try to guess as much items as possible. The player that guess the most, wins.



Add some Halloween sweets and chocolates and when the player guess what it is, let him/her eat it!






WELEN Toilet Basket Game

You will need


- Cardboard
- Marker
- Scissors
- Rope
- Tape
- Toilet paper rolls





How to do it

Unless you have enough toilet seats - who knows! - you have to make them off cardboard



- Trace the shape of a toilet seat on a big piece of cardboard or use tape to make a big one and cut it out
- Write the scores on the lids of the toilet seats
- Hang them on a rope leaving enough space between the toilet "basket" seats and the wall
- Put some tape around toilet paper rolls, so they don't fall apart!

How to play

- Each player can throw 5 paper rolls per turn
- If there are enough friends, you can make teams!
- · Note the scored points
- · The one who has scored more pints wins

Add fun making the players do the challenges!

Keep the paper rolls for the next Mummy competition game!

Challenges:

- One-eye Pirate. Before throw your rolls, cover one eye and challenge your self!
- Zombie. Throw the rolls hoping on one leg
- Mummy: Throw the rolls laying down in the floor
- Increase the distance one meter back between turns



WELELWEEN Mummy competition

You will need

- Toilet paper rolls
- Tape





How to play

The purpose of the game is be wrapped up like a mummy using toilet paper rolls in a given time.

- · Set teams of minimum two persons
- Set the time
- Start wrapping up your friend going around he/she as fast as you can
- The first to finish the mummy, wins. If the time given finish, the winner will be the one who is better wrapped up as a mummy



Adding fun:

- The mummies can make a race at the end, and the one that keeps more paper on it wins
- The mummy dance. Play music and ask mummies to dance until they get rid of the paper
