

Piggy ears and snout

You will need:

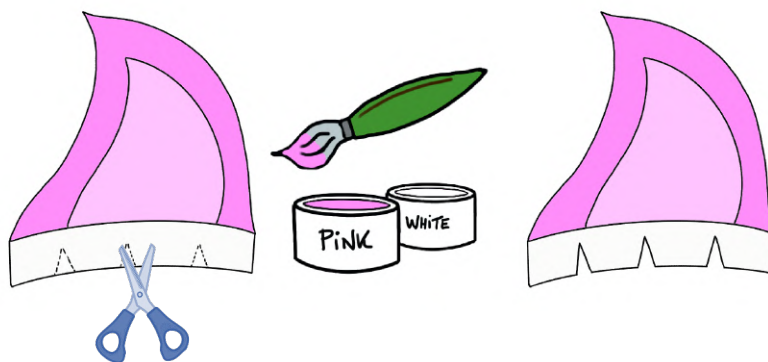
- Cardboard. Try to reuse an empty cereal container, shoe box or any cardboard box you can recycle
- Ears template (bellow)
- Hairband (optional)
- Paper roll
- Coloured pencils, markers
- Pink paint (better washable) or red and white to make pink 😊
- Scissors, Tape and/or gl
- Elastic band



How to do it?

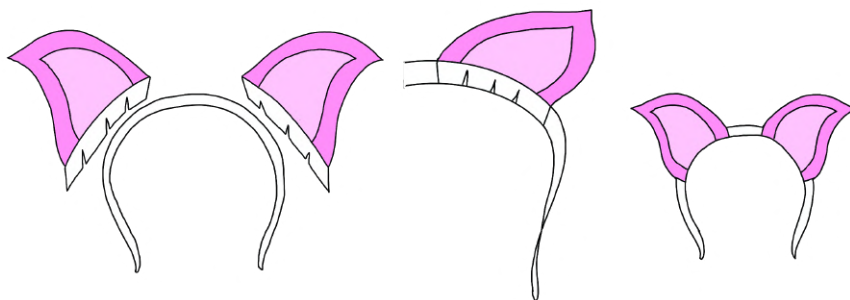
Piggy ears:

1 Colour and decorate the ears in two tones of pink.



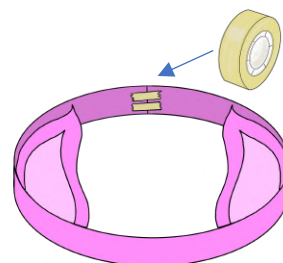
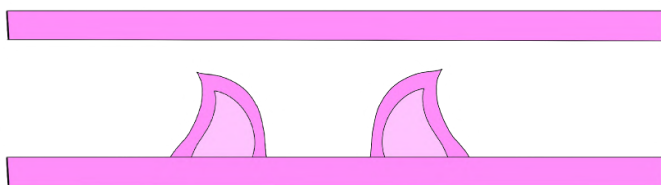
2 Glue them onto cardstock to make them firmer if you haven't print them out in cardstock, and cut out also the small dotted triangle

3 Glue the ears on the right and left side of the hairband and it's done!

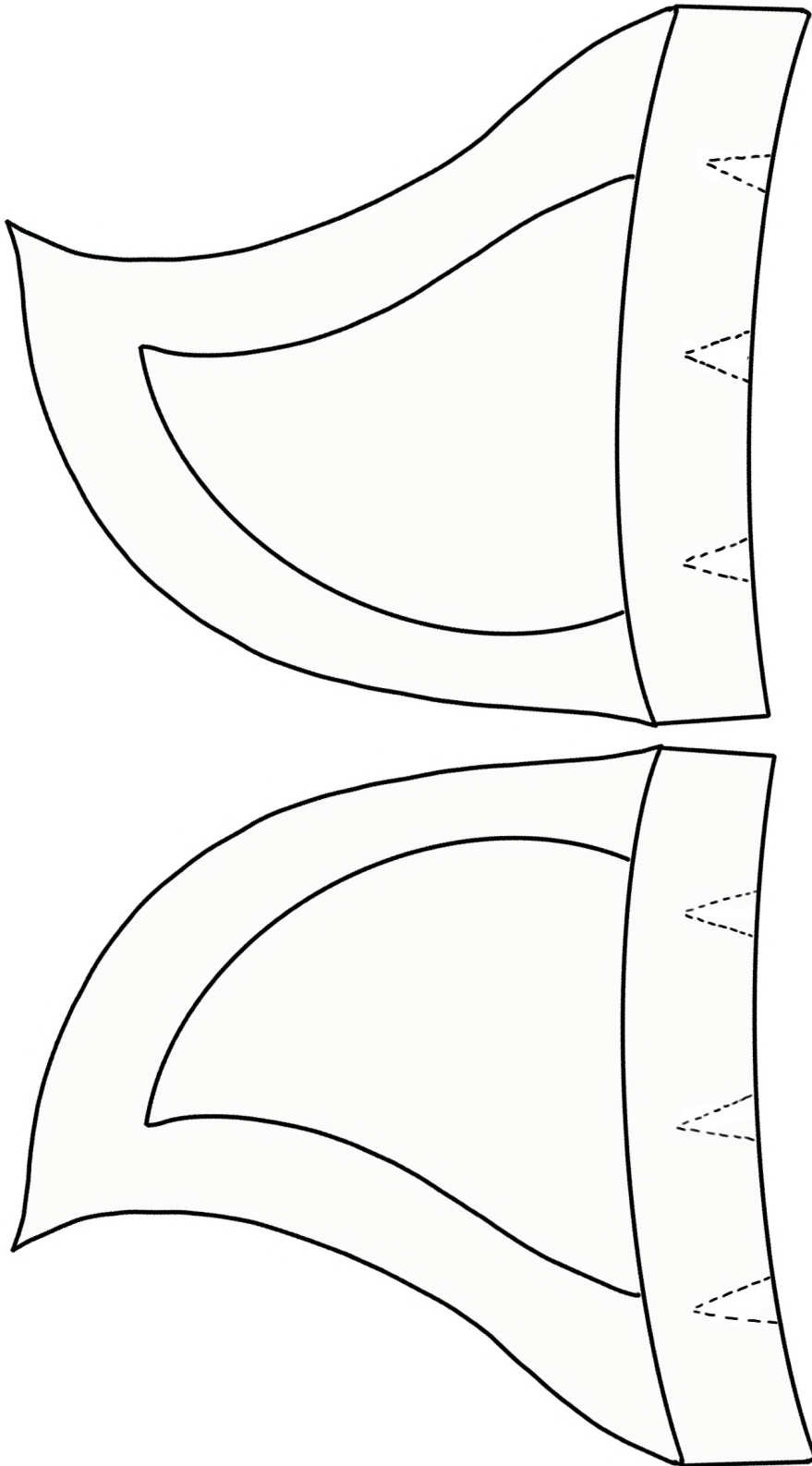


Don't have a hairband? No worries! Make a "Crown"

Use a strip of cardstock longer enough to place it around your head. Glue the ears on the sides and adjust the strip to your head with some tape. Easy!



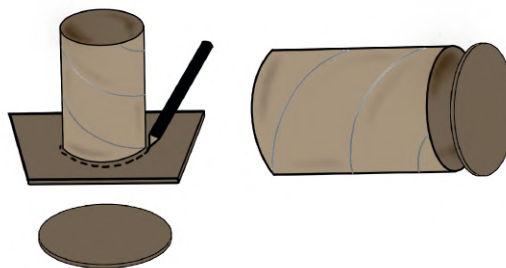
Piggy ears template



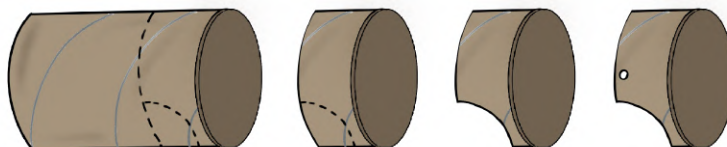
Piggy snout

How to do it?

1 Use the paper roll to trace a circle and cut out. Glue it to one of the ends



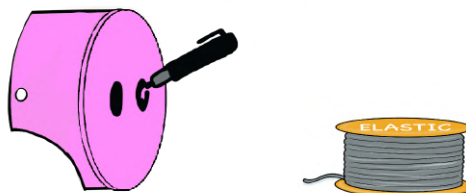
2 Cut out the paper roll approximately 6 cm (2.4 inches). Cut a semicircle in one of the sides (to breath well!) and make a small hole on each side



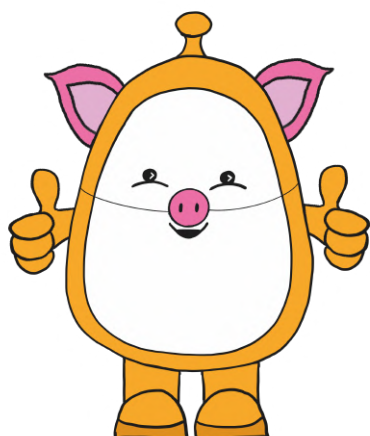
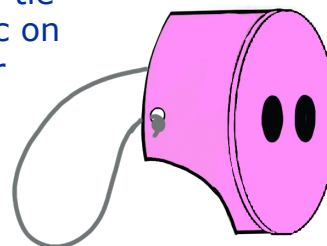
3 Paint it in pink or the colour you'd prefer.



4 Draw two black long circles (ovals)



5 Introduce a piece of elastic in one of the holes, tie and do the same with the extreme o the elastic on the other side. Now it will stay in place on your head.
